



Second Hand Heart Biography

Second Hand Heart's debut album *Tides* explores the light and shade within all of us, delving into dark cloudy landscapes before escaping to the colourful places beyond.

Arresting, soulful and raw in its execution, *Tides* is a self-assured debut release where melodies sprout from a nocturnal mood with a disarming intensity. A collection of neo-folk compositions, *Tides* speaks of longing, truth and courage.





The Second Hand Heart lads and lasses have performed with a mixed bag of similar kinned bands like Holly Throsby and



SECOND HAND HEART Hold On

Independent

Local band Second Hand Heart have an intriguing thing going, building *Hold On* around a simple, darkly romantic pop hook. The insistent yet understated drums add some drama, which is balanced by clear, ringing piano, a melodic bassline keeping it off the ground and mesmerising, unpredictable choral harmonies. Dreamy vocals are layered, edges overlapping, creating riveting aural textures to lose yourself in. There's a lot of promise here.
